Wonderland themed Booktoberfest raises thousands of dollars for OCLS

(Orlando, FL) – Friends of the Orange County Library System held Booktoberfest on Friday, October 5; the sixth annual Booktoberfest raised nearly \$11,000, a substantial increase from previous years. Funds raised will support programming and materials for the library system which provides services for all of Orange County.

"Booktoberfest raises vital funds for the library and it's a chance for us to show people the library in a different light," said Erica Lee, president of the Friends, an all-volunteer organization that exists to provide funds for library events and programs.

Guests enjoyed *Alice in Wonderland* inspired décor and activities including the Queen of Hearts favorite, croquet. Several guests even dressed as their favorite characters from the Lewis Carroll book, which is not-so-coincidentally nominated for PBS' The Great American Read.

Entertainment for the night included Central Florida Accordion Club and trivia hosted by radio personality and Friends President, Erica Lee.
