Library book drops to close beginning April 7

(April 3, 2020 – Orlando, FL) – The administration of Orange County Library System (OCLS) has announced that book drops for all 16 locations will be closed beginning Tuesday, April 7. Customers may return books at book drops through Monday, April 6. After that, they are asked to hold materials and return them when the library reopens.

The library remains closed, in keeping with orders from Mayor Jerry Demings and Gov. Ron DeSantis that Florida residents should stay at home to curb the spread of COVID-19 in our communities.

OCLS has extended the due dates for material from May 1 to **June 1**. During this period of time, library fines will be suspended.
