## **Orange County Library System cancels event and programs for May**

(April 2, 2020 – Orlando, FL) – The administration of Orange County Library System (OCLS) has announced that all library sponsored events and programs have been canceled for the month of May. While the library regrets having to make this difficult decision, we must do our part in following Orange County, Florida Government's directive to halt all non-essential services and to protect the health and well-being of our customers and staff.

OCLS had previously closed all sixteen locations to the public for the time being. The closures will remain in place until further notice.

The cancellation includes classes, events, camps, programs, staff-assisted studio sessions, tours, and outreach events. OCLS has a wide variety of digital offerings for library cardholders, including ebooks and audiobooks, live online classes, streaming TV and movies, music downloads, databases, digital magazines and more. The library's administration is taking the spread of COVID-19 very seriously and will continue to monitor the situation as it develops.
