Branch Library!**



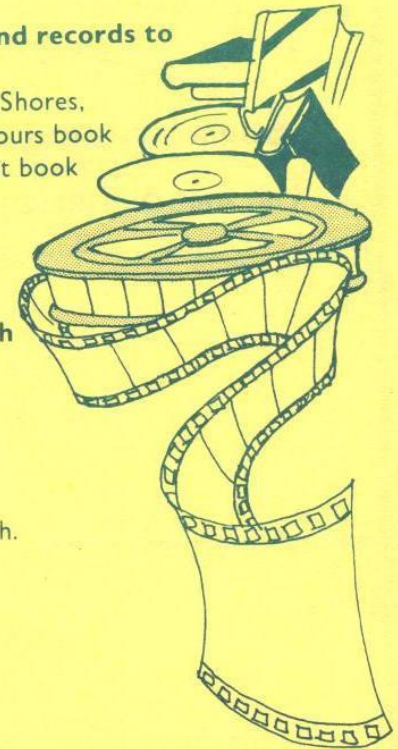
Check the map on the back of this sheet to find one that is convenient to your home or workplace. With one exception, they are open Tuesday through Saturday.

Just telephone the AV Department to make arrangements to pick up and drop off materials at your branch.

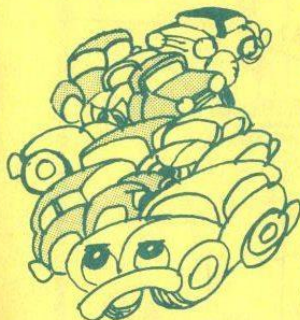


Avoid Wall Street

parking lots and Rosalind Avenue.

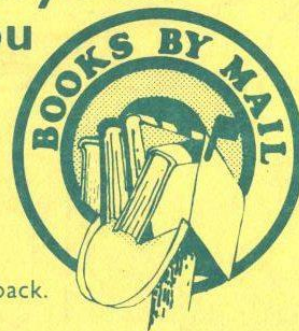

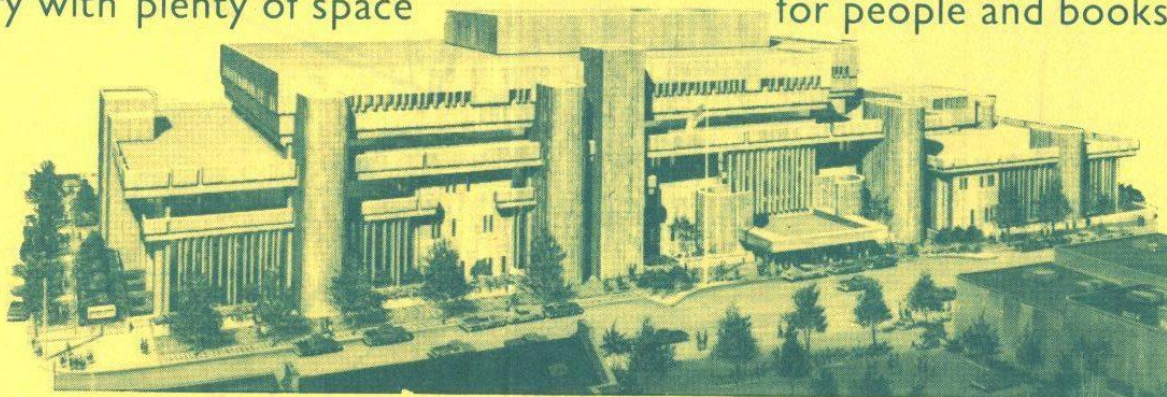
